No entries will be accepted by phone, email, fax or hand delivery. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at CWDSC's mailing address. Envelopes with more than 10 dogs' entries will be returned. Checks returned for insufficient

funds will invalidate the entry; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, are paid via certified check, money order, or cash, and received prior to the closing date. **Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Entry forms with email addresses will be sent entry receipts, as well as final confirmations, via email. The Scent Work Club of Central Wisconsin is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Entries without email addresses will receive only final confirmations after closing.

### WAITLIST INFORMATION

The Scent Work Club of Central Wisconsin is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trials' closing date/time. A maximum of **50 entries per day** in order of receipt will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by CWDSC **prior to the closing date of July 20, 2022, 5:00 PM**. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing on July 20, 2022, 5:00 PM. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trials will receive a full refund. All entries not given space in the trials will be shredded; if you wish to have your check returned, please send a SASE with your entry.

### GENERAL INFORMATION / EXHIBITOR NOTICES

#### **CLASS ELIGIBILITY:**

**Novice A/B Classes:** The A classes are for beginners. Those dogs who have earned a title in a particular element (In AKC or in another organization) and those handlers who are either judges or have worked as professional detection dog handlers must enter the B classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct classes. Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of qualifying scores.

**Advanced, Excellent and Master Classes:** To be eligible for Advanced, Excellent or Master you must have the lower title for that element.

**Detective Class:** This class is open to dogs who have achieved any Master title within the Odor Search Division.

**DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER:** AKC Scent Work classes are open to all dogs that are at least six months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. A dog that is individually registered with an acceptable foreign registry who is not yet registered with the AKC may compete for 30 days under the foreign registration number. After the 30 days, if no AKC number has been obtained and no extension has been granted, any qualifying legs earned subsequently under the foreign number will be cancelled. Condition of the Dog. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

**BITCHES IN SEASON:** Females in season may not participate. Those who come in season after the closing date will have entry fees refunded as stated under the **REFUNDS** section on page 4.

**MULTIPLE DOGS:** A handler may only handle one dog *per class* per event. (The hide does not routinely change between dogs within each class so handling more than one dog is not permitted.) Exception: Handler Discrimination, handler may handle multiple dogs.

**MOVE-UPS:** Move-ups in level will be offered from Saturday to Sunday (no same-day move-ups from Trial 1 to Trial 2). A completed Scent Work Trial Class Transfer Form must be submitted to the Trial Secretary before the end of the trials on Saturday.

**RINGSIDE:** Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the search area when required.

**SAFETY/BEHAVIOR:** The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dog(s) are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dog(s) are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

**LIABILITY:** It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Scent Work Club of Central Wisconsin and their agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. The SWCCW reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression.

No one shall have any recourse or claim against the SWCCW, the American Kennel Club, or any official thereof. Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for these events.

**COLLARS, LEASHES AND HARNESSSES:** During searches, the dog must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

**PRIZES AND AWARDS:** Placement ribbons will be awarded to first (blue), second (red), third (yellow) and fourth (white) places in each level of each element; all qualifying scores will receive a ribbon (dark green). New title rosettes will be offered to all teams finishing a title. **NO PRIZES/AWARDS WILL BE MAILED – Please make sure you pick up your awards prior to leaving the event!**

**HIGH IN TRIAL (HIT):** Only teams who participate in the same difficulty level in all elements offered (Container, Interior, Exterior, Buried), and qualify in each are eligible to win High in Trial. One High in Trial winner is chosen per difficulty level; there is no separate High in Trial for the Novice A and Novice B sections. The High in Trial is determined by adding the team's faults across the elements. If there is a tie based on faults, then the team's times across the elements will be summed and the faster-finishing team will win. The High in Trial award is not recorded by the AKC. Teams winning High in Trial will earn a rosette.

**REFUNDS:** No entry fees will be refunded if the trials cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fees will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

Bitches who come in season after the closing date will have entry fees refunded in full, upon written certification from a licensed veterinarian to the effect that the bitch in question is in season on the day of the trials. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one-half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

Prior to closing date, entries may be canceled, and entry fees will be refunded/checks destroyed.

**Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.**

## SITE INFORMATION

**TRIAL SITE:** It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial dates. Many search locations are real-life environments, and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

**POSSESSION OF ODORS AND TRAINING:** Chapter 5. Section 35 of the Scent Work Regulations states "No person other than those engaged in the administration of the trials shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trials, other than in the designated warm-up area".

**CHECK-IN & BRIEFING:** There will be an in-person general briefing at approximately 8:30 AM each day. Check-in will be self-serve at the gate of each element search. Please bring a pen or marker to place a ✓ by your name.

**TRIAL ORDER:** The specifics of the element orders will be in the judging schedule as part of the final details notice.

**WARM-UP AREA:** One labelled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day will be placed in the warm-up area and may also consist of blank containers. This will allow handler-dog teams to prepare themselves for the search prior to their run. Each team should limit their warm-up to two (2) minutes or less so that others may be able to use the warm-up area as well. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog.

**CRATING:** Crating space will not be available. All crating will be done outside or in your vehicle. The Scent Work Club of Central Wisconsin and the Amherst Fairgrounds will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items at the trial site.

**FOOD:** Volunteers will receive free lunch and beverages.

**SPECTATORS:** Spectators are encouraged. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be asked to leave the area by the judge. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search with handlers who have not run.

**SEARCH AREA CONDITIONS:** Searches may be indoors on matted, carpeted, packed dirt, concrete, or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, packed dirt or asphalt surfaces.

**SEARCH AREA SIZES (all in sq ft):** May be of any shape, and of the size specified in the regulations for each class.

Detective: The course must span both the interior and exterior of a building or structure. The total search area must be at least 2000 but not more than 5000 square feet. Any excluded areas will be clearly defined, but there will be no separate and distinct search areas. Teams may wander in and out of included rooms, and go back and forth between interior and exterior areas when seeking hides.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s) and are expected to keep the grounds clean. **Anyone witnessed not picking up after his/her dog(s) will be excused from the trial weekend with no monies refunded. Waste receptacles will be available at various locations around the trial site; the club does not want to lose this site for future trials.**
